

Postdoc position

A 2-year postdoctoral position is available in the *Biodiversity Dynamics & Macroecology* research group, at the CNRS Lab of *Ecology, Systematics & Evolution*, University of Paris-Saclay, Orsay, France.

The postdoctoral researcher will work in the InvaCost project, on the InvaCost project, with InvaCost collaborators. InvaCost is an international and interdisciplinary research project seeking to assess, extrapolate and forecast the economic costs of biological invasions. She or he will thus work InvaCost, eat InvaCost, dream InvaCost.

This project is with the AXA Research Fund of the University of Paris Saclay. Salary will be commensurate with the experience of the candidate. For a first position after the PhD, the net salary is ~2000€. For senior researchers applying, the salary will be higher. Social security and unemployment benefits from the French system are already included. This is a 24-month, full-time position, with possibility to extend if not tired of great team and fine food.

Candidates should have a Ph.D. and an experience in ecology or conservation. Most importantly, skills in data-mining and statistical analyses are essential. Excellent communication skills, in particular article writing, are also crucial. An experience in environmental economics is not indispensable, but would be a plus. Applications are particularly welcome from women and minority ethnic candidates who are under-represented in academic posts.

The CNRS is the 3rd research institute in the world. The University Paris Saclay is 13th in the Shangai ranking of universities. ESE is simply the best lab in the Galaxy.
